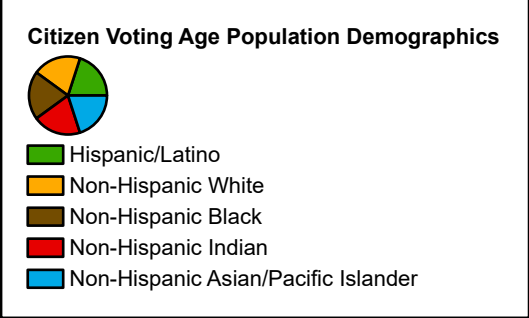
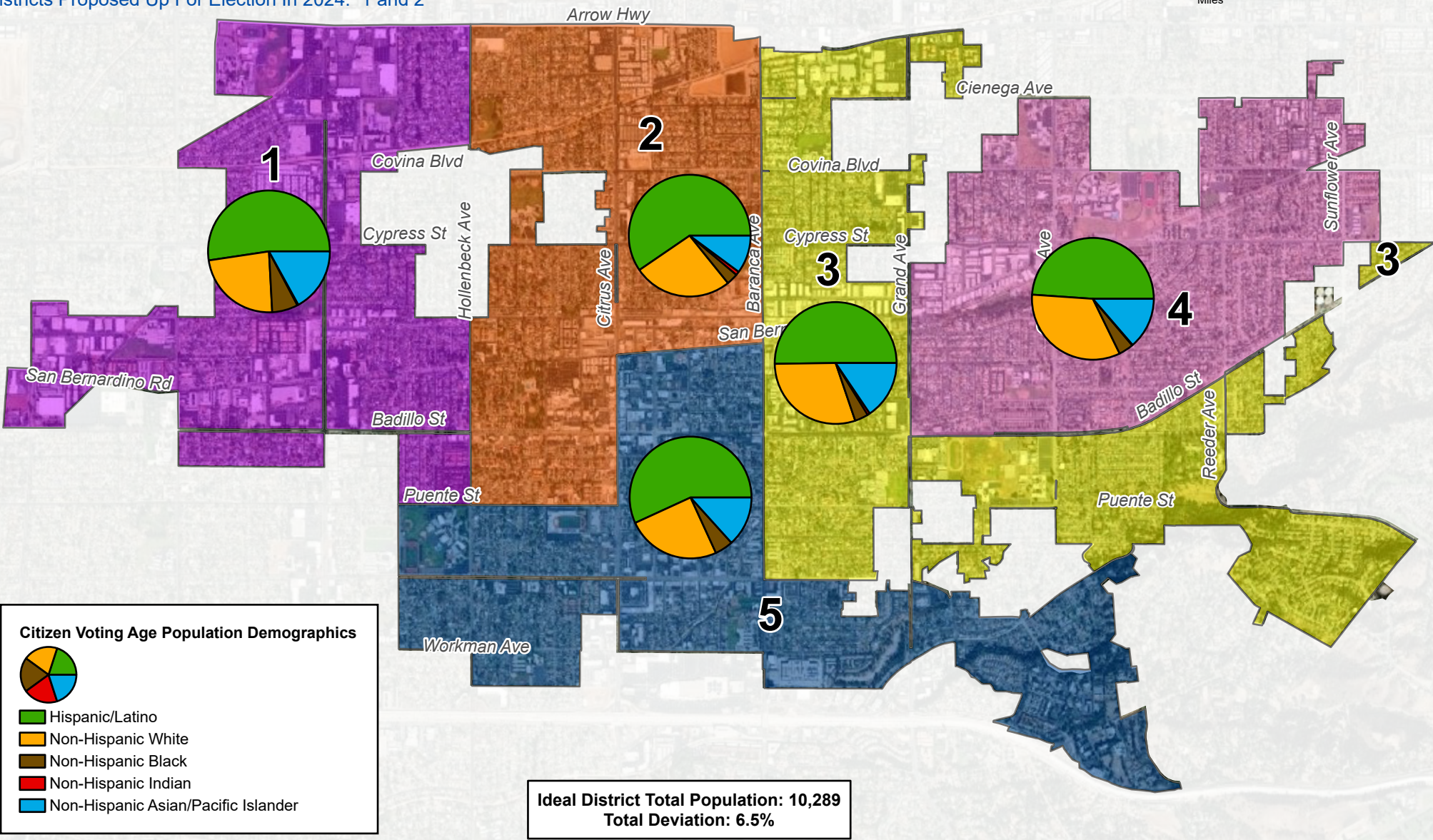
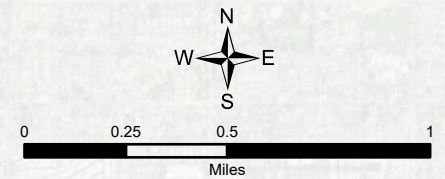

 Districts Proposed Up For Election In 2024: 1 and 2



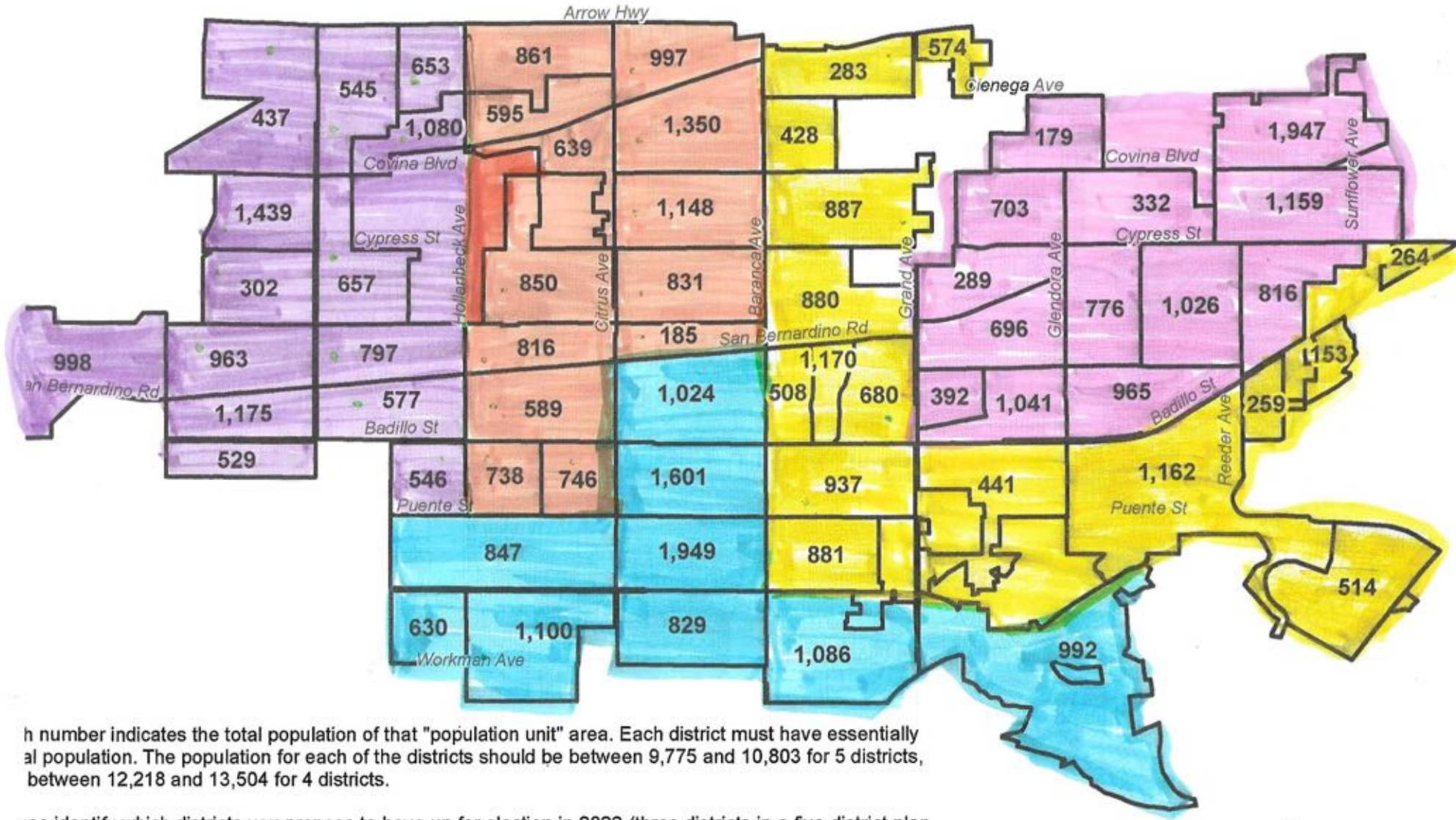

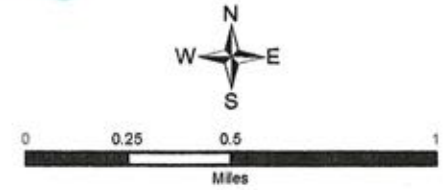
